Establishes pop-up skin cancer clinics to improve early detection for regional South Australians, who have a 15-31% higher rate of skin cancer

\$1,200

Tests a novel probiotic pill aimed at diagnosing bowel cancer earlier, with the eventual aim to improve participation rates in bowel cancer screening programs

\$2,000

Funds iPads and telehealth equipment for the children's oncology ward, to help a child communicate with their parents or nurse when they are in isolation after radiation treatment

Investigates a new drug and drug target for IDH1-mutated leukaemia that specifically blocks cancer cell growth
